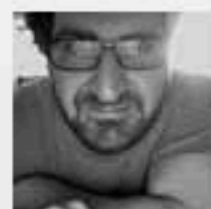

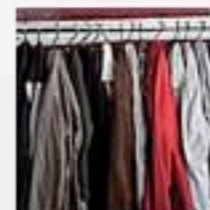

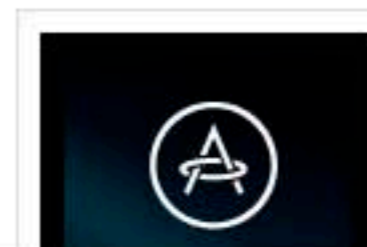

04. As Tough As It Gets: George "Elbows" McFadden In 1899

"When George McFadden passed away on May the 6th, 1951 Nat Fleischer, writing in Ring magazine, called him "a champion in any other era". And that was pretty much it for George. Nobody has really had very much to say about this pioneering lightweight since his death. But in 1899, "Elbows" McFadden matched a true ring legend no less than three times – all over the scheduled distance of 25 rounds. These three duels, separated as they were by only a little more than six months, should be enough to seal his place in ring lore, but McFadden also found time to match the two other outstanding lightweights of perhaps the greatest era in the history of arguably the deepest division of all, champions Kid Lavigne and Frank Erne."
